

### ALPBACH SUMMER SCHOOL ON EUROPEAN INTEGRATION 2015(ASSEI-B15)-Deadline 28th August 2016- APPLY NOW!

Club Alpbach Belgrade is proud to open call for applications for 10th edition of Alpbach Summer School on European Integration in Belgrade 2016 (ASSEI-B15). As official member of Forum Alpbach Network and European Forum Alpbach, in cooperation with University of Belgrade at Institute for Philosophy and Social Theory, school will be held from September 14th to 25<sup>th</sup>, 2016 in Belgrade, Serbia.

Each year, since 2006, Club Alpbach Belgrade has been organizing the Summer School on European integration in Belgrade. Therefore, this is the School's 9th edition and we are very proud of it! After successful cooperation in 2012, 2013 and 2014, ASSEI-B16 is again taking place at the Institute for Philosophy and Social Theory, University of Belgrade. Also, this year we celebrate the 10th anniversary of our Club.

Deadline for applications is **August 28th**, **2016** and <u>selected participants will be informed about selection</u> on 29<sup>th</sup> of August

### Eligible candidates

We are looking for 25 students (undergraduates and postgraduates) and young professionals under the age of 35 from the following countries: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Romania, Slovenia, Kosovo\* and Serbia, Western and Central EU member states.

#### **ASSEI-B16 Fee and Scholarships**


Partcipation fee for school is 1500 euros.











Based on GDP, ASSEI-B16 will grant **full scholarship** for slected participants coming from SEE region. This scholarship is covering costs of participation: accommodation, reading materials, field visit, social events, whole-day excursion. Scholarship is not covering traveling and visa costs.

Participants coming from Western and Central EU member states will be granted by partial scholarship and should pay contribution of 200 euros.

### **ASSEI-B15 Description**

After successful completion of the course, ASSEI-B15 participants will acquire a comprehensive understanding of the EU and global affairs, EU enlargement processes and SEE regional cooperation. The knowledge provided is based on an interdisciplinary approach and modern teaching techniques. The school is divided into three modules:

- 1. History and Culture
- 2. Society and Politics
- 3. Economy and Law

Each module is taught by two professors, meaning that the schools teaching faculty is comprised of 3 pairs of lecturers.

Classes are organized in the forms of lectures, interactive workshops and field visits to various institutions and organizations. Workshops and field visits are led by Mr. Bernd Kleinheyer. Academic coordinator of the school is Mag. Juergen Busch, together with Mr. Bernd Kleinheyer, dr Petra Bard and dr Petar Bojanic. Working language is English.


#### **ASSEI-B16 Aims**











A progress in the EU integration process means a growing need for further education in this regard in the SEE region. Also, there is a need for significant improvement of the cooperation between those countries. The project perceives regional cooperation and reconciliation as a precondition for the EU integration.

Recognizing this, ASSEI-B is built on two pillar-ideas:

- ♣ to enhance the knowledge about history, law, socio-economic integration, policy areas and political systems of the European Union among students, graduates, postgraduates and young professionals coming from various fields such as laws, economics, political sciences, technical sciences, linguistics etc.
- ♣ to encourage and initiate cooperation between youth of those societies, many of which have a history of conflicts and wars. Variety of country participants are coming from is an asset in this project. It will be used to initiate debates and discussions on topics such as post-conflict justice, prejudices and peace building. The project should develop a network of young, prosperous people, able to bring a European and regional perspectives to their environments.




Crisis of values- next big threat to the EU's survival?













Backround: On top of the debt crisis, the terrorism crisis, the migration crisis and the current British EU referendum crisis, the next big threat to the EU's survival may be a crisis of values.

Of all the crises to hit Europe over the past years, the migration crisis remains the greatest threat to the survival of the European Union. The arrival of more than a million migrants in 2015 provoked panic not so much because the numbers were in themselves unmanageable but because of fears that this was the tip of a very large iceberg. The EU may have managed to secure a degree of control over the numbers as arrivals have slowed to the low hundreds in recent weeks, but the sense of panic hasn't gone away. Indeed, the threat to the EU's survival may even be growing, for reasons that go beyond the immediate impact of migration and strike at the heart of the European project itself.
