The young participants are selected by a distinguished jury composed of business executives, EU policymakers, professors, senior journalists and equality defenders from all 27 EU Member States. At the last Winter School edition, one seat for the 'Western Balkans 6' was added. For the next Summer School, one candidate from Ukraine will also have the opportunity to attend.
