## Call for papers

We're pleased to announce that the **Circle U. Open School of Public Governance** is organising its first **PhD workshop in Public Governance**.

This workshop will take place **on 11 and 12 October 2023** at the **Department of Political Economy, King's College London (UK)**. It will gather PhD students and Postdocs from any social science background who study public governance (comprising all aspects of public policy, public administration, public management, and governance) using either qualitative or quantitative methods, or formal modelling. The purpose of the event is fostering exchanges, connections and collaborations between doctoral researchers across Circle U..

There will be a maximum of 18 presentations, lasting about 30 minutes each (including Q&A). Participants will be asked to send a paper (work in progress) in advance of the workshop. Each paper will have a discussant from the faculty of the departments affiliated with the Open School in the 9 partner universities (Aarhus, Belgrade, Humboldt, Louvain, King's, Oslo, Paris, Pisa, Vienna) and a peer-discussant from the participants.
